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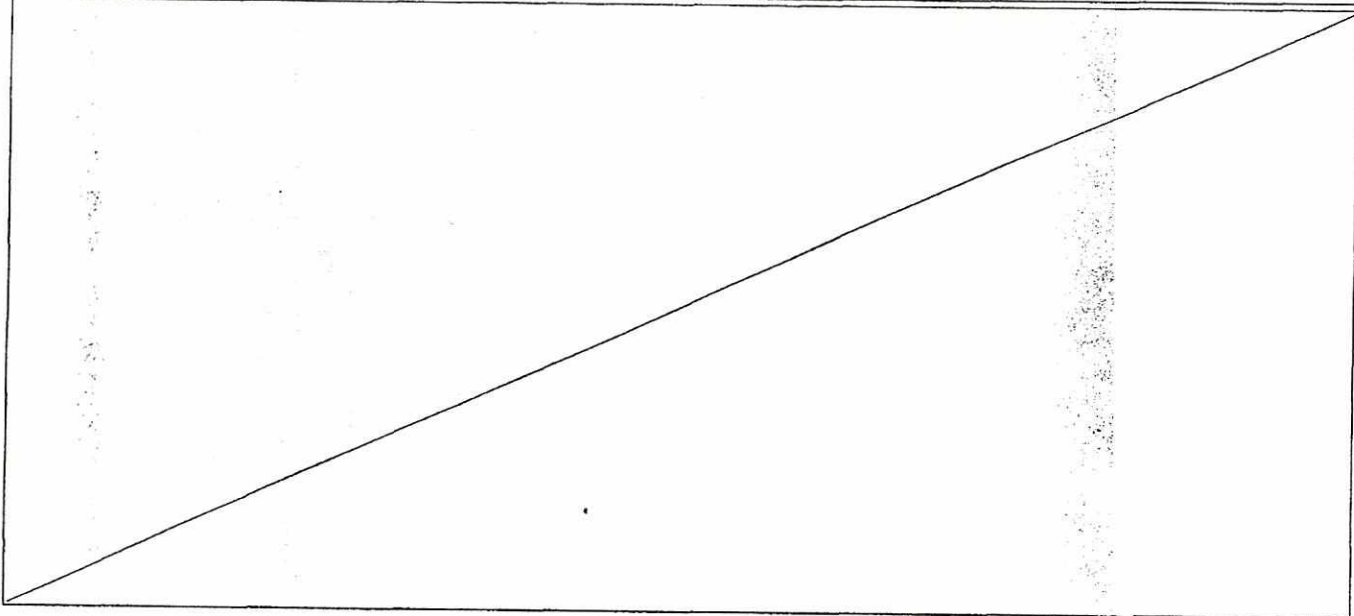

Health Attestation

- I certify that the wool:
- has been immersed of the wool in a series of baths of sodium hydroxide or potassium hydroxide.
 - has been subjected to chemical epilation using calcium hydroxide or sodium sulphide.
 - has been fumigated with formaldehyde in a hermetically sealed chamber for at least 24 hours. The quantities of the formalin and the potassium permanganate are respectively 53 ml and 35 g for each m³ of the chamber.
 - has been washed by immersing the wool in a water-soluble detergent at 60-70 °C.
 - has been stored at 18°C for four weeks or at 37°C for eight days.
 - is dried and in airtight packages.
 - The method of transportation does not present a sanitary risk for the wool and the wool is sealed after loading.
