Health Attestation

I certify that the wool:

- a. has been immersed in a series of baths of sodium hydroxide or potassium hydroxide.
- b. has been subjected to chemical epilation using calcium hydroxide or sodium sulphide.
- c. has been fumigated with formaldehyde in a hermetically sealed chamber for at least 24 hours. The quantities of the formalin and the potassium permanganate are respectively 53 ml and 35 g for each m² of the chamber.
- d. has been washed by immersing the wool in a water-soluble detergent at 60-70°C.
- e. has been stored at 18°C for four weeks, at 4°C for four months, or at 37°C for eight days.
- f. is dried and in intact new packages.
- g. The method of transportation does not present a sanitary risk for the wool and the wool is sealed after loading.
