

Order of the Minister of Agriculture and Maritime Fisheries No. 1379-10 of 29 Chaabane 1431 (11 August 2010) on products exempted from certain mandatory labelling requirements

THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND MARITIME FISHERIES,

Having regard to Decree No. 2-01-1016 of 22 Rabia I 1423 (4 June 2002) regulating the conditions of labelling and presentation of foodstuffs, as amended and completed by Decree No. 2-06-226 of 12 Jounada II 1428 (28 June 2007), in particular Article 4,

ORDERS

Article 1- In application of the provisions of Article 4 of the abovementioned Decree No. 2-01-1016 of 22 Rabia I 1423 (4 June 2002), the products imported or intended for a particular clientele and locally produced beverages, which are exempt from the use of the Arabic language in their labelling are as follows:

1- The imported products designated below:

- Products used as raw materials for processing or repackaging;
- Food and beverage products intended for particular nutritional uses;
- Food supplements;
- Food products destined for the diplomatic corps resident in Morocco;
- Food products imported under certain customs procedures (temporary admission and transit) in accordance with the regulations in force;
- Products for sporting, cultural or commercial promotion events during the period of the event;
- Food products distributed or exposed as samples;
- Food products imported for gifting purposes;
- Food products destined exclusively for hotels and restaurants;
- Alcoholic beverages.

2- Some locally produced beverages:

- Alcoholic beverages.

Article 2- This Order shall be published in the Official Gazette.
