

Order of the Minister of Agriculture and Maritime Fisheries No. 4260-12 of 17 Safar 1434 (31 December 2012) relating to prohibited substances to be administered to farm animals.

(OG No. 6140 of 04/04/2013, page 1705)

THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND MARITIME FISHERIES,

Considering Decree No. 2-10-473 of 7 Shawal 1432 (6 September 2011) taken for the application of some provisions of law No. 28-0 7 relative to the security health of food products, particularly article 53, point 2,

ORDERS:

ARTICLE 1 - (Modified and supplemented by Order No. 3330-23 of 15 Jumada II 1445 (29 December 2023) – (OG No. 7280 of 07/03/2024, page 898) - The list of substances that cannot be administered to livestock producing food products, provided for in point 2 of article 53 of Decree No. 2-10-473, shall be set as follows:

- 1- The substances below:
 - Antithyroid agents (thyrostatics);
 - Stilbenes derived from stilbenes, their salts and esters;
 - Sterides, Estradiol 17 β and its esterified derivatives;
 - β -agonist substances;
 - Bovine somatotropin;
 - Chloramphenicol;
 - Nitrofurans, including furazolidone;
 - Arsenical and antimonial substances, except those authorized as veterinary medicinal products;
 - Aristolochia spp and preparations thereof;
 - Resorcylic acid lactones (including Zeranol);
 - Chloroform;
 - Chlorpromazine;
 - Colchicine;
 - Dapsone;
 - Dimetridazole, Metronidazole, Ronidazole and other Nitroimidazoles;
 - Malachite Green (MG) and Leucobase (LMG);
 - Crystal Violet (CV) and Leucobase (LCV);
 - Brilliant Green (BG);
 - Any other medicinal substance used for purposes other than those provided for in its marketing authorization or indicated for animal species other than those appearing on said authorization;

2- The antimicrobial agents or groups of antimicrobial agents listed below:

a) Antibiotics:

- Carboxypenicillins;
- Ureidopenicillins;
- Ceftobiprole;
- Ceftaroline;
- Combinations of cephalosporins and beta-lactamase inhibitors;
- Cephalosporins Siderophores;
- Carbapenems;
- Penems;
- Monobactams;
- Phosphorous acid derivatives;
- Glycopeptides;
- Lipopeptides;
- Oxazolidinones;
- Fidaxomicin;
- Plazomicin;
- Glycylcyclines;
- Eravacycline;
- Omadacycline;

b) Antivirals:

- Amantadine;
- Baloxavir marboxil;
- Celgosivir;
- Favipiravir;
- Galidesivir;
- Lactimidomycin;
- Laninamivir;
- Methisazone/metisazone;
- Molnupiravir;
- Nitazoxanide;
- Oseltamivir;
- Peramivir;
- Ribavirin;
- Rimantadine;
- Tizoxanide;
- Triazavirin;
- Umifenovir;
- Zanamivir;

c) Antiprotozoa:

- Nitazoxanide ;

- d) Antibiotics used for purposes other than those provided for in their marketing authorizations or prescribed for animal species other than those listed on said authorization;
- e) Any other antimicrobial substance used to promote growth or increase yield.

ART. 2. - This Order shall be published in the Official Gazette.
