

Decree n° 2-86-760 of 5 January I 1407 (6 January 1987) fixing the fat content of processed milks, as completed and amended.

THE PRIME MINISTER,

Considering the Law No 13-83 relating to the fraud prevention on goods, promulgated by the Dahir No 1-83-108 of 9 Moharram 1405 (5 October 1984);

Considering the Decree of 26 Moharram 1345 (6 August 1926) relating to the monitoring of milk production and regulation of milk and dairy products trade, as amended and completed);

After review by the Council of Ministers, held on 21 Rabia II 1407 (24 December 1986),

DECREES :

FIRST ARTICLE. (Amended by Decree No 2-98-601 of 17 Ramadan 1419 (5 January 1999)) – The properly authorized milk processing establishments can only prepare and offer for sale pasteurized, sterilized or UHT sterilized milks at the following minimum fat content:

- 1** - Pasteurized, sterilized or UHT sterilized whole milk: 30 grams of fat per liter.
- 2** - Pasteurized, sterilized or UHT sterilized semi-skimmed milk: 15 grams of fat per liter.
- 3** – Pasteurized, sterilized or sterilized UHT skimmed milk: 0 gram of fat per liter.

ART. 2. (Repealed and replaced by Decree No 2-02-94 of 22 December 1423 (4 June 2002)) - Pasteurized, sterilized or UHT sterilized milks can only be sold under the specific names referred to in the above first article.

ART. 3. (Repealed and replaced by Decree No 2-02-94 of 22 December 1423 (4 June 2002)) - In addition to the indications provided for in article 10 of Decree No 2-00-425 of 10 Ramadan 1421 (7 December 2000) referred to above, the labeling of pasteurized, sterilized or UHT sterilized milks shall contain the following indications:

- * in addition to the sale's label "pasteurized milk", "sterilized milk" or "UHT sterilized milk", the terms "whole", "semi-skimmed" or "skimmed", depending on the case;
- * the registration number of the pasteurization or sterilization facility;
- * the indication after opening, keep in cold place and consume quickly.

ART. 4. - Decree No 2-69-398 of 18 Kaada 1389 (26 January 1970) on the standardization of pasteurized milks is repealed.

ART. 5. - The Minister of Agriculture and Agrarian Reform shall be responsible for the enforcement of this decree which shall be published in the Official Gazette.
